Lead Based Paint Requirements: Pursuant to the Lead-Safe Schools Protection Act (Education Code Section 32240 et seq.) and other applicable law, no lead-based paint, lead plumbing and solders, or other potential sources of lead contamination shall be utilized on this Project, and only trained and state certified contractors, inspectors and workers shall undertake any action to abate existing risk factors for lead.

Fingerprinting Requirements: Unless exempted, the successful bidder shall comply with the applicable Requirements of Education Code Sections 45125.1 and 45125.2 with respect to fingerprinting of employees who may have contact with the District pupils. The Contractor shall also ensure that its subcontractors on the Project comply with the application requirements of Sections 45125.1 and 45125.2.
