RESOLUTION NO. 2007-160 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE DECLARING ITS INTENT TO ORDER THE ANNEXATION OF ZONE 85 TO LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 89-1 CONSOLIDATED OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE PURSUANT TO THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ACT OF 1972 FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND SERVICING OF FOSSIL FILTERS; ADOPTING THE PRELIMINARY ENGINEER'S REPORT; GIVING NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ANNEXATION OF ZONE 85; ORDERING AN ASSESSMENT PROCEEDING; ORDERING A MAILED BALLOT ELECTION; AND DIRECTING NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING AND THE ASSESSMENT BALLOT TO BE MAILED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIII(D) OF THE CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION AND SECTION 4000 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (hereinafter the "Board of Supervisors") of the County of Riverside (hereinafter the "County") has adopted Resolution No. 2007-159 on April 17, 2007 initiating proceedings for the annexation of Zone 85 (hereinafter "Zone 85"), as described and shown in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated of the County of Riverside, State of California, (hereinafter "L&LMD No. 89-1-C") pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (hereinafter the "Act"), which is Part 2 (commencing with Section 22500) of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code (hereinafter the "Street and Highways Code"), and ordering the preparation of a report (hereinafter the "Report") regarding the proposed annexation of Zone 85 and the assessments to be levied within Zone 85 each fiscal year beginning fiscal year 2007/08 for the maintenance and servicing of fossil filters within the public right-of-way within said Zone; and WHEREAS, such proceedings shall comply with the requirements of Article XIII(D) of the California Constitution (hereinafter "Article XIII(D)"), the Act, and Section 4000 of the Elections Code requiring voter approval of the proposed assessment to be levied by L&LMD No. 89-1-C for Zone 85; and WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors by Resolution No. 2007-159 directed the Director of the Transportation Department, or his designee (hereinafter the "Engineer"), to prepare and file the Report with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Sections 22608 and 22585 et. seq. of the Street and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIII(D); and WHEREAS, said Engineer has filed the Report with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the Report has been presented to and considered by the Board of Supervisors; and WHEREAS, the Applicant has executed a "Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election" allowing for the election to be held on June 12, 2007; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution of intention pursuant to Section 22624 of the Streets and Highways Code, which fixes and gives notice, pursuant to Section 22626 of the Streets and Highways Code, of the time and place of a public hearing on said Report, the annexation of Zone 85, and the assessments to be levied on parcels within Zone 85 beginning in fiscal year 2007/08; and NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors in regular session assembled on April 17, 2007, as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board of Supervisors, after reviewing the Report, finds that:

(a) The foregoing recitals are true and correct. (b) The Report contains all matters required by Sections 22565 through 22574 of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIII(D) and may, therefore, be approved by the Board of Supervisors. (c) The annual assessment for fiscal year 2007/08 on all parcels within Zone 85 proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C will be \$3,058.24 per acre.

Section 2. Intent. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares its intention to order the annexation of Zone 85, as described and shown in Exhibit "A", to L&LMD No. 89-1-C, and to levy and collect an annual assessment on all parcels within Zone 85 and parcels of property within Zone 85 commencing with the fiscal year 2007/08 as set forth in the Report. The Report expressly states that there are no parcels or lots within Zone 85 that are owned by a federal, state or other local governmental agency that will benefit from the services to be financed by the annual assessment. The annual assessments will be collected at the same time and in the same manner as property taxes are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of property taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of said assessments.

Section 3. Boundaries. All the property within boundaries of Zone 85 is proposed to be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C, and that all property in the unincorporated area of the County as described and shown in Exhibit "A".

Section 4. Description of Services to be Provided. The maintenance and servicing of fossil filters authorized for Zone 85 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C are: (a) The maintenance and servicing of fossil filters within the public right-of-way including the removal of petroleum hydrocarbons and other pollutants from water runoff.

Section 5. Amount to be Levied. The assessment to be levied upon each parcel that benefits from the annexation of Zone 85 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C will be \$3,058.24 per acre for fiscal year 2007/08. As stated in the Report, the total budget for Zone 85 for the fiscal year 2007/08 is \$3,150.00; there is 1 parcel that is to be assessed that aggregates to 1.03 acres. The annual assessment will be increased by the greater of two percent (2.0%) or the cumulative percentage increase, if any, in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers ("CPI-U") for the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County California Standard Metropolitan Statistical area ("Index") published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor. The annual CPI-U adjustment will be based on the cumulative percentage increase, if any, in the Index as it stands on March of each year over the base Index for March of 2007. Any increase larger than the greater of 2.0% or the CPI-U annual adjustment requires a majority approval of all the property owners within Zone 85. The Board of Supervisors will levy the assessment in each subsequent fiscal year until the Board of Supervisors undertakes proceedings for the dissolution of Zone 85 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C. The annual assessment will fund the services described in Section 4 of this Resolution. For further particulars, reference is to be made to the Report on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 6. The Property to be Annexed. The property to be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C is Zone 85. The boundaries of Zone 85 are located within the unincorporated area of the County and are described and shown in the Report and Exhibit "A".

Section 7. Report. The Report, which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and which has been presented to the Board of Supervisors, is hereby approved. Reference is made to the Report for a full and detailed description of the services, the boundaries of Zone 85 and the annual assessment to be levied upon assessable lots and parcels within Zone 85 proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C.

Section 8. Public Hearing. The question of whether Zone 85 shall be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C and an annual assessment levied beginning with fiscal year 2007/08 shall be considered at a public hearing (hereinafter the "Public Hearing") to be held on June 12, 2007, at 9:30 a.m., at the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors of the County at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California.

Section 9. Majority Protest. Each owner of record of property within Zone 85 is to receive by mail an assessment ballot that shall conform to the requirements of Section 4 of Article XIII(D) and Section 4000 of the California Elections Code. The assessment ballots are to be returned prior to the Public Hearing. L&LMD No. 89-1-C shall not impose assessments on property within the boundaries of Zone 85 if there is a majority protest with regard to the annexation of Zone 85. A majority protest exists if, upon the conclusion of the Public Hearing, the tabulation of the assessment ballots submitted in opposition to the annual assessment to be levied upon assessable lots and parcels within Zone 85 exceeds the assessment ballots in favor of the annexation and assessment of Zone 85.

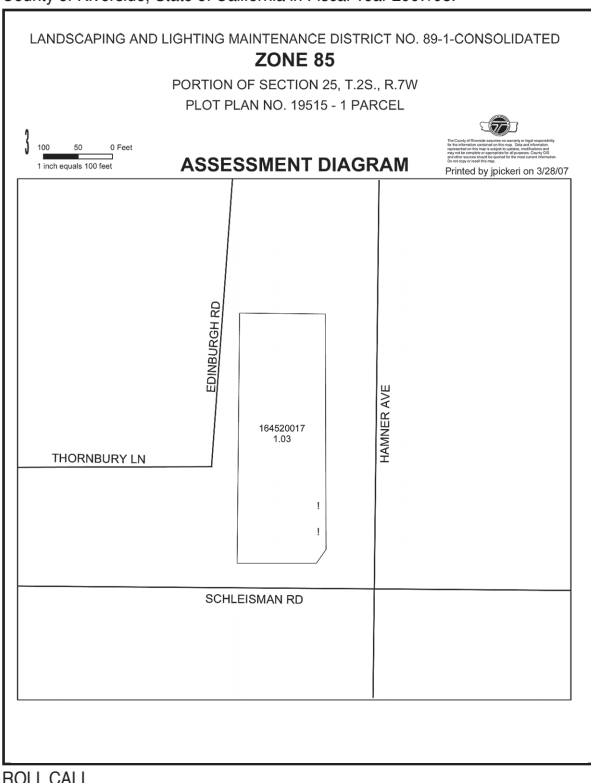

Section 11. Notice of the Public Hearing. Notice of Public Hearing with regard to the annexation of Zone 85 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C shall be given consistent with Section 22626 of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIII(D). The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall give notice of the Public Hearing by causing a certified copy of this Resolution to be published once in the Press-Enterprise at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the Public Hearing that is June 12, 2007. Publication of this Resolution is to be effected by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Jeffries Supports Bill to Help Firefighters

Bill supported by CDF Firefighters, California State Firefighters Association Opposed by California Professional Firefighters Union

SACRAMENTO - Assemblyman Kevin Jeffries (R-Lake Elsinore) testified yesterday on behalf of AB 1700 in the Assembly Committee on Revenue and Taxation. "AB 1700 is critical to help alleviate 'out of pocket' expenses incurred by California firefighters," remarked the Assemblyman. "Both career and volunteer firefighters often purchase safety gear and small tools that help them more effectively do their jobs."

AB 1700, authored by Assemblyman Doug La Malfa, would allow an 80% tax credit for firefighters who use personal funds to buy qualified firefighting gear. Examples of

qualified expenses include extra firefighting helmets, jackets, heat shields, flashlights, boots and other equipment that will alleviate risks associated with fighting a fire. AB 1700 was supported by the CDF Firefighters and the California State Firefighters Association.

In an awkwardly worded opposition statement, the California Professional Firefighters (CPF) Union opposed the measure stating that "it would be more efficient to directly purchase fire equipment than to provide a tax credit for purchases that might be otherwise made." According to the opposition letter, the CPF Union "strongly

opposed" the relief measure and then testified in opposition during the committee hearing. Jeffries, who served 29 years as a volunteer firefighter and worked the past 5 years with the Riverside County Fire Department before being elected this past November, at first thought the opposition letter from the CPF Union was just a joke being played on the author. It became clear that the CPF Union was not joking when the Sacramento lobbyist actually testified against their own firefighters.

"The reality is that both volunteer and career firefighters are forking money out of their pocket to help save lives and fight fires," said Jeffries. "We should be encouraging and helping firefighters to do the best possible job, including offering tax breaks."

AB 1700 was held on the committee's suspense calendar which effectively kills the bill.

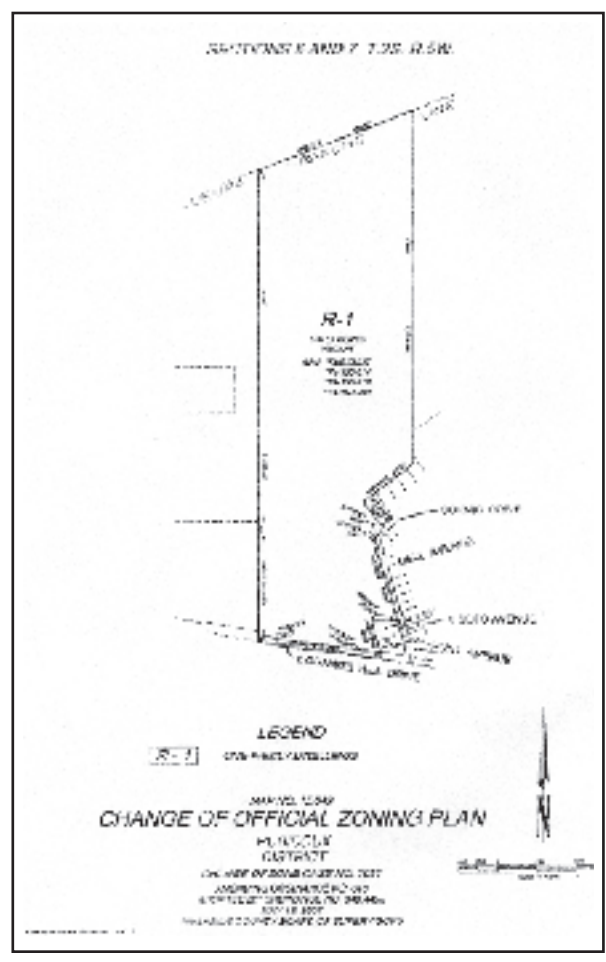
